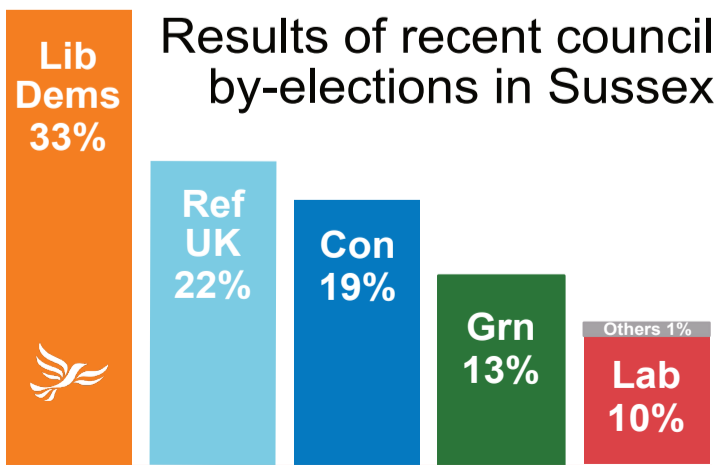

THE CONSERVATIVES FAILING RECORD AT COUNTY HALL

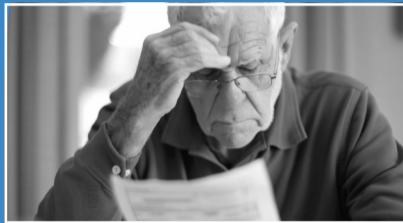

They have racked up a £56 million budget black hole and are now taking a £70 million "payday loan" from the government just to survive. My priorities for Hailsham Market Division
