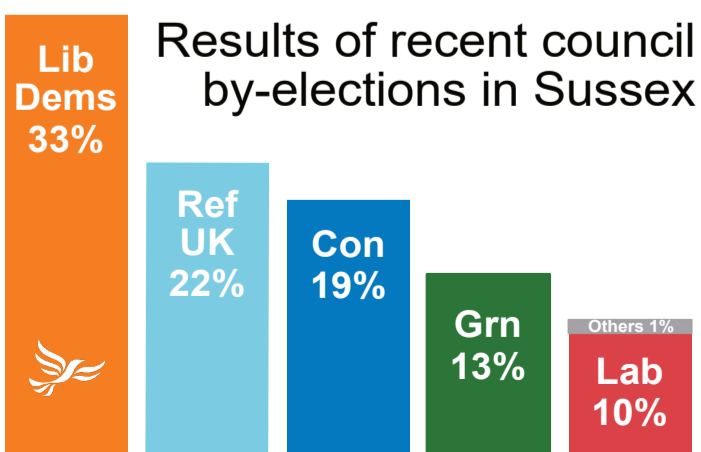

THE CONSERVATIVES FAILING RECORD AT COUNTY HALL

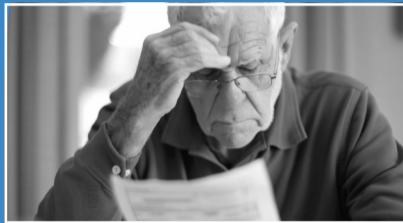

My priorities for Arlington, East Hoathly and Hellingly



"I love living in Wealden. It's seen a lot of change over the years - some good, some bad. And some things haven't changed that need to, like the constant lack of services to the most vulnerable.

My three main priorities are...

- Decades of poor decision making by the Tory Cabinet, locking in a contract till 2030 means that our roads are in a mess. We need them to be safer around schools and push for a sustainable way to fix our roads that provides value for money and lasts longer.
- With the introduction of an online booking system at our household waste sites fly tipping has increased. It's polluting our countryside. I will work with others in changing the system and take tougher action against fly-tippers.
- Adult social care is a mess with the Council closing support centres. Special needs provision for children is totally inadequate with parents having to fight every step of the way. The most vulnerable in our communities are at risk and I want to change that.

FIX OUR ROADS AND PAVEMENTS

People across our community are fed up with unsafe roads and dangerous potholes.

In more rural areas the routes to school can be hazardous. **Laura Murphy** said: "I'll push for a mandatory 20 mph around schools and managed crossing points so that our roads are safer for children and families."

In addition the Conservative run County council have left our roads to fall apart whilst wasting taxpayer's money on pet projects.

Laura added: I'll also support moves to work with the contractors on expanding an innovative

approach to road repairs using proven materials and techniques that halve the time taken, reducing disruption and last many times longer, saving money."
